Barry Lee Deaven, 78, of Duncannon passed away peacefully at his home on October 22, 2022. Born May 22, 1944, he was the son of the late Ralph and Vera (Weiss) Deaven. He was preceded in death by a sister, Bonnie Deaven, and son, Timothy Deaven.

Barry is survived by his wife of 58 years Carolyn (Reese) Deaven; his brother Terry Deaven and wife, Debbie; son Gregory and wife, Michelle; son Michael and wife, Stacey; and daughter in law Elizabeth Deaven. In addition, 8 grandchildren, and 12 great grandchildren called him Pappy.

His career at Hershocks spanned six-decades working with his father, siblings, and sons. He served as a Watts Township supervisor for thirty-years, president and chairmen of Perry County Economic Development Authority and Corporation, president of Northstar Insurance Captive, and held offices in various other business organizations such as American Subcontractors Association, Harrisburg Builders Exchange, Capital Region Economic Development Corporation.
