Charles E. Lupfer, 93, of Airy View Road, Shermans Dale, went to be with the Lord on January 1, 2025 in The Bridges at Bent Creek., Mechanicsburg.

Born February 13, 1931 in Shermans Dale, he was the son of the late Harry and Eleanor (Owen) Lupfer.

Charlie was Mr. Shermans Dale. He was a generous, kindhearted, hardworking, community oriented, charitable, stubborn, selfless loving father, husband, grandfather and great grandfather.

He was a farmer at heart and loved tinkering with tractors and heavy equipment. He was a former board member of the Bank of Landisburg, a former Carroll Twp. Supervisor, member of The Farmers Bureau. He belonged to the Oliver Tractor Club, Perry County Old Iron Collectors, he was a milk hauler and was a member of Eastern milk Producers. He drove a school bus for 64 years and was instrumental in the life of the Shermans Dale Ambulance Club and Fire Co.

He was the widower of his late wife, Pauline (Frownfelter) Lupfer to whom he was married for nearly 70 years. Surviving are two sons, Allen Lupfer and wife Kim and Timothy Lupfer and wife Michele and daughter in law Darla Lupfer all of Shermans Dale. 6 grandchildren and 9 great grandchildren. In addition to his wife and parents, he was preceded in death by a son Dennis Lupfer, Sister Jeannette Fry and grandson Brandon Morrison.
