Christopher S. Bowman recently of Shermans Dale, PA passed away October 27, 2022 at Penn State Hershey Medical Center after a long battle with leukemia.

He was born in Vineland, NJ in March 1970. Chris graduated from Warsaw Community High School, Indiana in 1988 before enlisting in the U.S. Army.
