Clyde "Charlie" Charles Bishop Jr. 56, formerly of Landisburg, Perry County, passed away Wednesday, July 7, 2021 at Bethany Towers in Mechanicsburg, Pa. Born March 6, 1965, he was the son of the late Clyde "Charlie" Charles Bishop Sr. He was formerly employed in the fast food industry for many years. He was an active member of the Mountain Side Congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses, in Harrisburg, where he served as a ministerial servant.
