Dave was a life-long dairy farmer. He was a 1951 graduate of Perry Joint High School and was a member of Christ Lutheran Church, New Bloomfield. Dave was also a member of the Pennsylvania Farmers Association: he was past president of the Perry County Farmers Association (now known as Perry County Farm Bureau). He also served on the Board of Directors of Agway in Loysville and had been a part-time rural mail carrier.

Surviving are his wife of 55 years, Patricia (Logero) Weller. Two sons, David T. Weller and wife Sunday and Dennis Weller. He was grandfather to 8 grandchildren and 1 great grandson. He was preceded in death by 3 brothers, John, Elmer, and Charles Weller and 4 sisters, Virginia Kretzing, Dorothy Smith, Adella Spease, and Nancy Orris.
