



## Diana E. Wilt

November 6, 1938 - November 3, 2025

Diana E. Wilt, 86, of Paige Hill Road, Landisburg, went to be with Lord on Monday, November 3, 2025 in West Shore Hospital surrounded by her loving family.

She was born November 6, 1938 in Harrisburg and was the daughter of the late Edward and Mildred (Dawson) Demy.

She grew up in Rockville, Pa. where she attended grade school and was a 1957 graduate of Susquenita High School where she lettered in field hockey and basketball. She rescued and cared for abandoned animals all of her life.

She was an avid fisherman and hunter thanks to her father. She enjoyed many seasons of hunting and fishing with her father, her sons and their dog, "Tag." She was an avid reader and author. She loved history and learning. She also wrote many short stories, such as "Willow's Wonderful Treehouse", "The Red Velvet Locket" , "Wind Friend"; and "Of Seashells and Pearls", which is inscribed on her sisters headstone. In her retirement, she travelled to many states in pursuit of her interest in Hiking. She and her family hiked the US Army Heritage and Educational Trail in Carlisle in mid October.

She was the widow of James H. Wilt. They were married in 1957 and James died in a traffic accident in 1989. They had built a home in Landisburg.

Surviving are three sons, Michael, David and Timothy. In addition to her husband, she was preceded in death by a daughter, Kelly, who died in infancy.

During the ensuing years she worked as a nurse and EKG Tech at the former Polyclinic Hospital in Harrisburg. After her retirement in 1984, she worked in the family business (PMSI) until 2001.
