Frank Mortimer Magee Jr., 89, of New Bloomfield died peacefully on Thursday, January 1, 2015 at The Manor at Perry Village, New Bloomfield. Frank was born in the Harrisburg Hospital on Wednesday, July 8, 1925 to Frank Mortimer Magee Sr. and Mary Rhinesmith Magee. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a cousin, Sally Rothrock Davey. He is survived by a cousin Marianna Rothrock Flowers of Mechanicsburg and an extended family.

After graduating from Phillips Academy Andover and Yale University, where he was a member of the Society of Orpheus and Bacchus, he served in the United States Army as a Cryptographer in the Signal Corp, China Theatre, during WWII. He was a management consultant, serving as the publicity and house manager for both the Santa Fe Opera House, Santa Fe, NM and the North Shore Theatre, Beverly MA.

After residing in both New Mexico and New York City, Frank returned to New Bloomfield to own and operate the family business, Perry Printing Co. He was active in the Harrisburg Community Theatre and served on the Board of Trustees of Carson Long Military Academy where he directed the glee club. The family extends deep gratitude to Frank's long time, in home, caregiver, Mary Jo Owen, as well as the staff of the Manor At Perry Village for their heartfelt care.

Interment will be in New Bloomfield Cemetery. It will be both private and at the convenience of the family.
