Gerald Henry Byrd, 75, of Cessna Street, Carlisle, went to be with the Lord on Friday, March 17, 2023

at his home. He was a beloved husband, father and grandfather.

Born March 11, 1948 in Granite City, Illinois, he was the son of the late Clarence and Claretta (Nolan) Byrd.

Jerry was a very articulate, funny, neat, precise, particular, coin collecting, dry humorist who could fix anything. He was truly a "Mr. Fix-it!" He was a graduate of Madison High School, Illinois. He grew up watching, from his home, the construction of the Gateway Arch being built across the Mississippi River. He attended Community Christian Fellowship, Carlisle and had been a maintenance supervisor for 17 years at Camp Of The Woods, he was also Fire Chief for Spectacular Fire Co. and was retired from Middlesex Township Municipal Authority. He was a patriot and served his country in the United States Navy aboard the USS Independence during the Vietnam War.

Surviving are his wife of 51 years, Phyllis (Brunner) Byrd. Twin sons, Jonathan and wife Laura of North Carolina and Joel and wife Amanda of Lancaster and a daughter, Julia Byrd of Maryland.

3 Granddaughters, Lucy, Alexandra and Maggie. A brother, Shawn Byrd of Oklahoma, three sisters, Patricia Duncan of Kentucky, Betty Hartley of Missouri and Raeleene Rowe of Iowa. He was preceded in death by a sister, Marilyn Jonas.

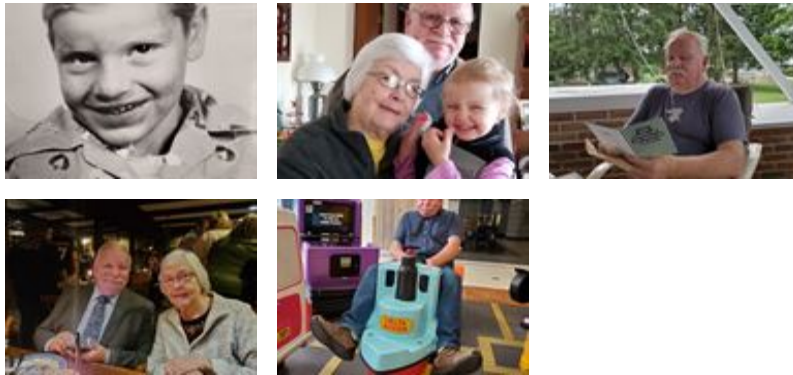
