James Edward Loy, 75, of Loysville Pennsylvania, passed away on May 20, 2025. Born on April 11, 1950, he was a graduate of West Perry High School in 1968 and was a lifelong member of Centre Presbyterian Church. Jim was hard-working, dedicated, and a talented craftsman. Jim grew up on the family dairy farm and after graduation began working for his uncle, Mort Loy, in construction around Perry County. Then, on June 26, 1976, Jim married Sue Neely, and they began their life's journey together with a move to Pitman, NJ. Jim spent 33 years working as a Pipeliner and Welder starting at Woodbury station in New Jersey with Sohio Pipeline and BP Pipeline then finishing his career at Buckeye Pipeline at Booth station in Pennsylvania. 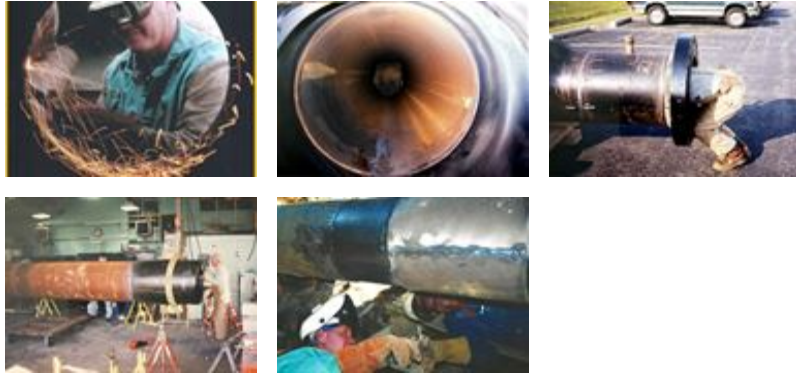

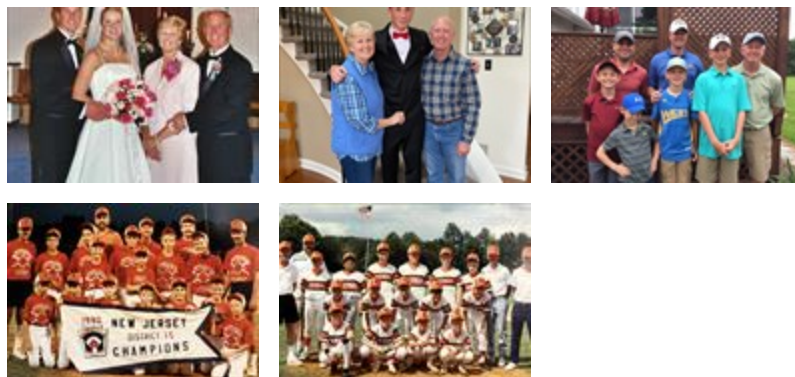
