Dr. James Darlington Sendi of Mechanicsburg, died Saturday December 25, 2021 at UPMC West Shore Hospital. Dr. Sendi was born December 24, 1930 in Harrisburg to the late Guy W. and Lucille M. (Bortell) Sendi. He was a Korean War combat veteran serving in a Mobile Army Surgical Hospital.
