Her love of cars was apparent when she got her driver's license. She liked to drive like Dale Earnhardt - fast, like she was on the Daytona raceway. Jen would always keep her vehicles spotless and if you rode in her car, you better not leave any trash inside. Jen's love of vehicles carried into her adulthood and so did her need for speed. Jen automatically became her dad's favorite with her love of the New York Yankees ...her siblings being Baltimore Orioles fans had lower ranking within the family. The family all came together again during football to watch Washington finish last every year. Jennifer Radel married her husband, Christopher Radel, on May 15, 1999. After starting a life together, they eventually had their only son, Mitchell Radel, on October 2, 2004. Jennifer, who many know as Jen, was an outgoing individual who always wanted to help others. She spent her day-to-day life after her son was born always caring for him and other family members. Many know Jen as a kind soul who reached for the stars to achieve anything she could to make others happy. Jen loved spending her time outside of work going on drives around Perry County in her '57 Chevy, and listening to her favorite music from the 80s and 90s. She enjoyed spending time with her family in their house, watching her favorite soap operas, going shopping on the weekends, and going outside to connect

with nature. Around nine months ago, Jen learned she had colon cancer, which had spread to multiple parts of her body including her liver. Jen wanted to spend any moment she could with her family and four dogs, Shep, Reggie, Cooper, and Mattingly, who she loved dearly. After going to countless amounts of treatment, Jen unfortunately succumbed to cancer. Jen spent her last few days surrounded by her family members when she unexpectedly passed away.
