Josephine A. Hench, 99, formerly of New Bloomfield, went to be with the Lord early on Sunday, July 7, 2024 at The Bridges at Bent Creek, Mechanicsburg. “Jo”, as she was known by her friends, was born June 11, 1925, in New Bloomfield and was the daughter of the late Clarence and Luella (Neilson) Askins.
