Lewis (Lew) R. Morrow passed away surrounded by family at the age of 71 on January 13, 2026 following a sudden and brief illness. Lew was born on May 1, 1954 to Bill and Hazel Morrow and grew up in New Bloomfield, PA. He studied at Gettysburg University before transferring to Susquehanna University where he would graduate with a Bachelor's degree in Geology, and more importantly, meet his best friend and wife of nearly 50 years, Kate Morrow (nee McCarty). Lew and Kate moved around the country supporting each other's educational and career aspirations, from Illinois to Louisiana and Houston. Eventually, they relocated and settled in Millerstown, PA where they raised their three children together.

Lew spent the next several decades pursuing his passions of farming, carpentry and tennis, while also being a dedicated father and husband. He believed in giving back to his community, serving as township supervisor for Greenwood Township, coaching youth baseball and providing mentorship and opportunities for young, aspiring farmers.

Lew is survived by his three children, Hunter (Jessica) of Hamilton, VA, Ben (Kyra) of Apex, NC and Anni (Eric Becker) of Denver, CO; five grandchildren (Amelia, Felicity, Nicholas, Josephine, and Jackson); 3 siblings, Ann Morrow Weigl, Zeke Morrow, and Fred Morrow, along with several nieces and nephews.
