Together they enjoyed taking many trips to events with various Carlisle High School sports teams

and the marching band.

During their retirement years, she and Tuffy traveled throughout the United States and also enjoyed taking cruises to Alaska and the Caribbean. She had a special love for flower gardening and it was an annual tradition to go flower shopping for their beautiful home in the mountain. She especially loved hummingbirds and watching them and all the deer and other wildlife from their front porch. She also enjoyed many fun shopping trips with her daughter and grandchildren. She made every holiday very memorable by cooking/baking her special dishes for family to enjoy and passed down many family recipes. One of her greatest joys was attending sporting and other events for her children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren and she always tried to be at as many as possible to support them and cheer them on.

She was a lifelong member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Carlisle where she sang in the church choir for many years.
