March 19, 1944 - August 11, 2024

Lynn Groff, 80, of Dauphin, PA went home to be with his Lord and Savior on August 11, 2024.

He was the husband of Dottie (Graybill) Groff for 52 years.

Born in Lancaster, PA on March 19, 1944, Lynn was the son of the late Lester and Mildred

(Wenger) Groff. He was a graduate of Hempfield High School (Landisville, PA) and Bethel

College (North Newton, KS). After graduation from college, he served for two years in Bogota,

Columbia, in lieu of military service. He and Dottie served together as missionaries in the

Dominican Republic with Unevangelized Fields Mission (now called Crossworld) from 1975

1979, involved in church planning.

Lynn was employed for many years with Graybill Processing in Rheems, PA (working for his

brother-in-law Dave), which later became Amplisource. He worked there fulltime right up until

his death. Lynn could always be counted on to be a dependable and steady worker.

Surviving in addition to his wife, Dottie, are 4 children: Rebecca Groff of Falls Church, VA; Michael Groff

of Lancaster, PA; Steven (Laura) Groff of Holly Springs, NC; Timothy (Becca) Groff of Omaha, NE;

and five grandchildren – Ethan Groff, Evan Groff, Elise Groff, Emma Groff, and Olivia Groff. Lynn

loved and faithfully prayed for each member of his family. He was preceded in death by an

infant daughter, Julie Ann, and three sisters: Lucille (Jack) Huber, Joan (Lowell) Amand, and Carol (Don) Horning.

Lynn accepted Christ at the age of 12. He sought to be a man of God's Word and to know the

God of the Bible. He was a member of Perry Community Church (Shermans Dale, PA) and was a

valued part of the church's pre-service prayer team.

Lynn enjoyed being a good friend and neighbor. He was a real outdoors man and loved raising

beef, gardening, hunting, fishing, and camping – and he loved his country. He was most

comfortable in sneakers, jeans, and a cap!

Lynn will be deeply missed, but the impact of his life will live on.

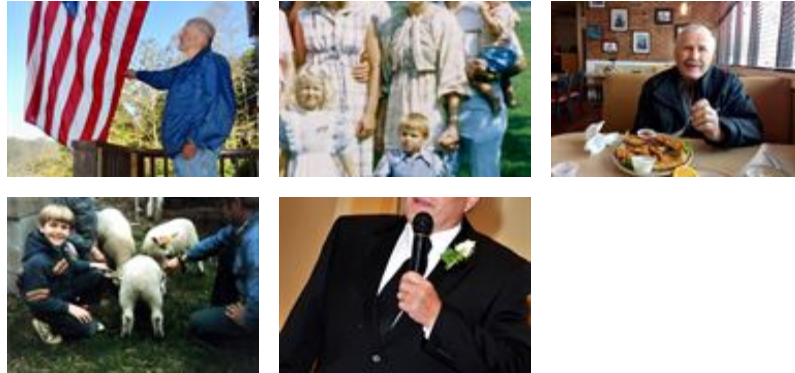
