“ My mother, Margaret Lillian Barnett Roddy, was known as ‘Margie’. She was named for her mother and paternal grandmother, Lillian Barnett Roddy. She was born at home to Stanhope Orris Roddy and Margaret Isabel Kline on Saturday, January 13, 1934, in New Bloomfield, Pennsylvania. She passed away of natural causes in the early morning of Sunday, April 27, 2025, at the age of 91.

*Margie grew up, married Jackie Lee Becker, and remained in her home until her death. As a child, she lived with her parents, grandmother Julia Radel Kline, and beloved aunt, Sarah Kline, her favorite. It was a home rich in learning and family history. As a child, Margie showed interest in genealogy and history, which became lifelong passions.*

*She began schooling in a one-room schoolhouse, graduating in 1952, and then went on to the University of Pennsylvania in Philadelphia.*

*Margie was a published author for the school histories of Perry County, PA. She was a member of the Shakespeare Oxford Fellowship Society, Perry Historians, and the Perry County Historical Society, and published several books.*

*Her daughter, Elizabeth, will receive her genealogical diaries and research. In her honor, she will continue the work that began 50+ years ago. The family tree, with 2,500+ ancestors, was finally uploaded to FamilySearch.org in 2010. Margie verified that she was a descendant of the Mayflower and a few lines of nobility. As the lead genealogist, she led 10+ family members, online, to continue their genealogical research. It is a model tree and an example for new genealogists to follow.*

*Jackie Lee Becker was the love of her life. They shared many happy and wonderful years. They were married for 61 years.*

*She leaves to mourn her husband, Jack Becker, brother Neil Roddy, twin daughters Liz and Cathe, grandchildren Keith, Eliot, Nina, Jan, and Theo, and Great-grandchildren Ember and Miles. She also leaves two adoring nieces, Candace and Krystal, and their children.*
