Ray W. H. Kaseman, 91, entered the presence of his Lord on Monday, August 7, 2023.

Born in Shamokin on May 29, 1932, he was the son of the late Ray H. Kaseman and Martha M (Culton) Kaseman.

Surviving is his wife of 68 years, Jane (Lankford) Kaseman, a son Brad Kaseman, daughter Debra Keith and husband John of Wila, a sister, Marica Thomas, and husband David of Lewisburg. Other family members include his brother-in-law Raymond Lankford of York, 9 nieces and nephews: Dennis, Scott, David, Elaine, Linda, Caroline, Scott, Steve, Matthew, and their lovely families.

"Kasey" was always a gentleman. He and his sister Marcia had a wonderful childhood in the booming town of Shamokin "when coal was king". He shared many stories from that colorful era where the family revisited yearly to enjoy a hot dog at the famous "Coney on Independence." Kasey loved the game of golf and played every chance he was given. When he wasn't playing golf, shining his shoes or regripping his clubs he was artfully designing his garden where he would only redesign things 7 times for Jane.

Kasey graduated Shamokin High School in 1950 and East Stroudsburg University in 1953 where he met Jane, and they married in 1955. He served in the Army Signal Corp from 1955 until 1957 in Augsburg Germany. He taught health and physical education at Green Park High School and West Perry Jr. High School for 30 years. He also coached baseball, soccer, and varsity basketball. Against all odds, he coached the team into the mid-state championship. He received his final mulligan late in his life when he accepted Jesus into his heart.

We love him and will greatly miss him until we meet again.

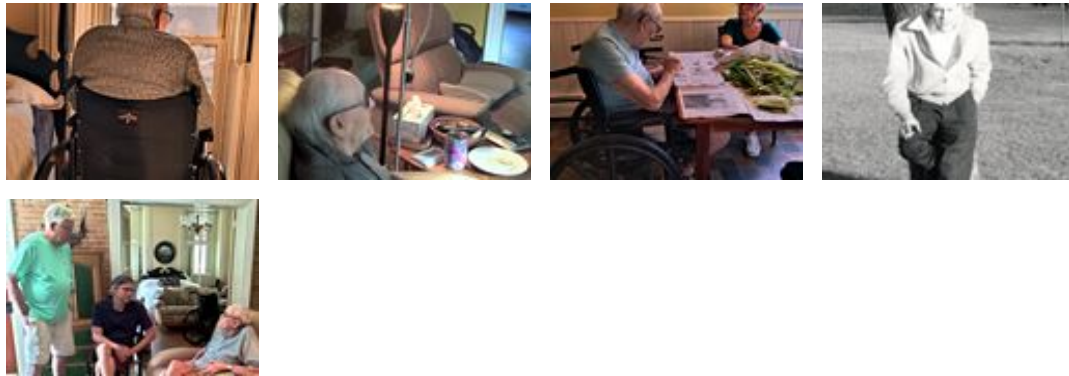
