Roger Carlyle Stepp, 91, of Duncannon, formerly of Mechanicsburg, went to be with our Lord and Savior on April 23, 2024. He was preceded in death by his wife, Dottie Westbrook Stepp on March 23, 2024, his parents Samuel O. Stepp and Margaret Fleming Stepp, a sister Enid Nehrig, brothers Samuel, Ken, and Thomas Stepp.
