Truman L Earnest, 88 of New Bloomfield died at home on Monday, October 4, 2021. He was born January 24, 1933 to the late Paul and Mildred Earnest of Liverpool, PA as the middle of 11 children.

Truman served in the Army in Korea as a military police and then trained as a barber, later becoming a machinist. He was an avid walker and talker on the streets of New Bloomfield and in earlier days fancied himself a hunter, despite his limited success rate. He was a member of the New Bloomfield United Methodist Church and of the New Bloomfield VFW.
